**Council received awards:** At the diocesan meeting on Saturday September 16 our council earned three state awards. The Columbian award is given to councils that did four activities in each of these category: Church, Community, Council, Family and Youth. The complete council award is earned if the council complete a certain number activity in these seven categories: Administrative, Church, Council, Membership, Community, Culture of Life, and Family/Youth. The third award was for 100 percent donation to the State PKD program. One hundred percent if we donate \$3.65 per member to this Catholic Education program.

**Received Checks:** Also at the diocesan meeting the council received two checks. The first one was for \$1619.77 which will be given to the Stanley-Boyd Special Education Department. This money was earned from the tootsie roll drive we had in May. The second check was for \$908.00 which will be deposited into the KC disaster fund which will used to help individuals or family in need.

**PKD:** Penny a Knight a Day program has collected \$1.9 million since it started in 1968. The money collected is given to the Bishop of each diocese for Catholic Education. At the diocesan meeting a check for \$9156.46 was given to the LaCrosse diocese Bishop Callahan. This money was what all the council in the LaCrosse diocese collected from its members that voluntarily contributed to this program of \$3.56, a penny a day for Catholic education.
