PKD: At the Diocesan meeting the Knights from the LaCrosse Diocese gave Bishop Callahan \$8229.67 for Catholic Education in the diocese. The Penny a Knight a Day is a state program where KC members donate \$3.65 to this fund each year. Our council members donated \$500.05 thus earning the PKD 100 per cent award.

Tootsie Roll Check: The Wisconsin State Council Knights of Columbus, Helping People with Intellectual Disabilities Program has released the final figures for the 2018 Tootsie Roll Drive. The drive raised \$726,736. Councils around the state received back \$499,782 which will go to their local groups or organization that assist the intellectually disabled. Our council received back \$1365.41 which will be given to the Stanley-Boyd Special Education Department. The State Council still has \$147,824 to distribute through grant application process.
