Old Business:

1. Update on cash raffle (Diane Weggen): Tickets are printed. 2@\$500 highest prize and least prize is \$50. 1 in 10 chance to win. 500 tickets total- 50 draws. This raffle is replacing the Christmas bazaar this year. With the sale of all the tickets, profit is \$4,881 (\$5050 in prizes given out). There is an expense of \$69 to print the tickets.

2. Update on Pork dinner Oct. 22nd (Lorrie Sonnentag): The date is set but there hasn't been a meeting yet. 159 potato dumplings were made and frozen by Loraine Seichter, ready for the dinner.
3. Update on Women's Day Sept. 23rd (Jenn Rogalski): Invitations were sent by email. Speaker: Jacquelin Van Hert speaking on Catholic femininity: Mary as our model. As people are invited, we are asked to report anyone who claims to no longer be members back to the parish office. Further information about the event was given to the group. Sign up for volunteer opportunities were set out and call lists were given out to personally invite parish ladies.
4. Status of development of Mission statement/bylaws/P&P's: Executive committee met to develop the first draft of the bylaws. Copies were available to read through.
5. Quilt for NCCW status – Jean Felber: Donated by the quilting group from our parish. The quilt is beautiful and has arrived in Utah for the silent auction at the National PCCW convention. The quilt is believed to be valued at well over \$1000 and a minimum bid was asked to start at \$300

New Business:

1. Donation to Fr. Emmanuel: a motion was made to donate \$300 by Kim Gundlach 2nd by Diane Weggen, vote passed unanimously to make the donation to Fr. Emmanuel for his mission for his parish in Africa (roof repair on the parish rectory with 42 outposts)
2. How to request money/reimbursements: Bring expense requests to the treasurer so all new expenses are covered by the combined ASPCCW.
3. Funeral Dinner coverage for non-members: We currently charge \$250 for non-members' funerals. There is a contract available for non-parish members to rent the hall. Funeral Committee was formed to organize a contact person for the funeral homes and contact list for servers and help (possibly 2 per church): Kristin Pickering, Julie Lingen, Mary Fitzimmons, Connie Pozdell, Pam Dorn, Lorrie Sonnentag. We do NOT provide any food for non-members. A process for non-member funerals will be developed while current plans are to continue with parish member funerals being handled by each church chairperson and their respective groups.
4. Use of Website--? Newsletter: It was decided that having the minutes published on the parish website would be adequate for the members.
