

All Saints PCCW Minutes

March 21, 2024 7PM

St Joseph's Church

Call to order at 7:01pm by President Jean Felber

Opening Prayer: Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel

Pastor's Message: Fr. Felix (unable to attend) sent the message that Fr. Benzmillier is having an anniversary Mass and dinner by invitation only on June 9th and is asking for volunteers to help with serving the catered dinner and cleanup.

Old Business:

1. Treasure Report: Ann Wagner sent report with Jean Felber
ASPCCW: \$9,381.55 (confirmation gifts have been paid \$111.11)
Stanley: about \$7700
Boyd: about \$6600
Cadott: about \$30,300
2. Circle Reports:
 - St Joseph: Pam Dorn: Marlene Bohl gave a gift (prayer card) to be hung in the kitchen
 - Holy Family: Ann Wagner: Main statues are finished with restoration and will be picked up and paid for. Candle holders- refinishing is done. New bases for the statues are being worked on.
 - St. Rose of Lima: Lorrie Sonnentag: Cadott had 2 funerals and the kitchen remodel has started. Wheeled carts have been ordered and they were informed that 50% down payment was needed for the kitchen cabinets.

New Business:

1. Spiritual Bouquet for Father and Deacon for Easter: In leu of physical gifts, we give gifts of prayer time (rosary, novena, Mass intention). Jean will collect intentions and write them out in a card to give to Father and Deacon for Easter. The hope is to put the gift of money that would regularly be given to them for Easter into the construction plans.

2. Funeral Dinners: restructure Jenn/Pam

Looking at funeral volunteer structure to combine as one unit for all three churches. Jenn Rogalski and Pam Dorn brought the plan to the meeting after speaking with several people throughout the parish. A funeral committee is being established.

3. Funding:

- a. Father Felix asked Kim Gundlach to organize a bus and order group tickets for The Answer; Eucharistic celebration in La Crosse on June 7. Kim asked for financial support from the PCCW to reimburse the parish for the bus. LuAnn Wilkom made a motion to give \$2000 for the cost of the bus and any extra money can go toward water/snacks/scholarships. Seconded by Julie Lingen. Approved.
 - b. Parish building fund-in Father and Deacon's names. Discussion tabled for future discussion.
 - c. Gifts for 1st communion (already approved) estimated \$300
 - d. Wreaths for clergy buried within the Parish: Julie Lingen found 2 priests buried in Stanley area, Lorrie Sonnentag found 4 in the Cadott area and Ann Licht found 6 in Boyd area. Still getting the information for Edson cemetery and Wilson cemetery. Ann Licht made a motion to allow up to \$200 to purchase wreaths when the total is determined. Seconded by Lorraine Seichter. Approved.
 - e. Shelving for PCCW-Jenn (See #5)
 - f. A conversation was started about what each church PCCW funding would be needed on an annual basis. So far, Boyd: summer flowers for planting and Christmas lights as needed. More to added later.
4. PCCW Social Day Jenn Rogalski: planning a PCCW Social Day looking for people to help plan this event to be held by early summer. Charlene Zenner offered to help organize this event.
5. PCCW storage room in the parish hall (old school portion): Jenn Rogalski offered to build. She presented a budget for the supplies. Jenn did a price comparison on pre-built shelves vs. building shelves for the size of totes that we have. This storage room could be used by all 3 churches for storing historical items as well. Julie Lingen made a motion to give up to \$350 for this project. Seconded by Pam Dorn. Approved.

6. PCCW survey results Jenn Rogalski: provided a handout with notes on the Women's Day event and the survey that was given out at the event.
7. Jean Felber mentioned an event on April 13th at the Radisson in La Crosse called "Celebrate Life" and offered the website information if anyone is interested in attending. Registration is available online: www.LDCCW.org
8. Mercy Sunday Collection (previously "Low Sunday")—April 6&7, Each location will have PCCW members do the collection and will keep the collection separate to give to the Diocese.
