Meeting called to order at 7pm

Opening Prayer: Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel--Jean

Pastor's Message: Fr. Felix (unable to attend but sent a message): The hall remodel in Stanley is coming along nicely with some delays that are beyond our control. The Sportsman's Club got special permission to use part of the building at the end of Sept. The hope is to open in Oct. with the hope of having an "open house" event for the community. Father would also like to have Bingo on Tuesday nights in the fall through the spring and would like the PCCW to work with the Knights of Columbus (local and Chippewa chapters) with the hope of it becoming a source of financial support for the facility.

Old Business:

1. Treasure Report: Ann Wagner-As of July 10th, the balance is \$4494 Approximately \$19,000 was taken in and \$15,000 went out for the previous year.
2. Circle Reports:
 - St Joseph: Pam Dorn-nothing to report
 - Holy Family: Ann Wagner-the sewing group is planning a craft show for Saturday, Nov. 23rd and they are looking for vendors
 - St. Rose of Lima: Lorrie Sonnentag-the kitchen project is coming along with \$17,168.29 in expenses so far. They are waiting for some equipment from Thorp Equipment. Lorrie brought copies of a prayer from "Priests for Life" as we approach the presidential election.
3. Funeral Restructure update: Jenn Rogalski (unable to attend)- Committee met and are working on developing groups for serving

and are developing a standard supply list in order to purchase supplies in bulk for the various events and locations.

New Business:

1. Prayer Chain—individual areas vs one united: general consensus was to keep prayer chains as they are but remain open to discussing options in the future.
2. Christmas Bazaar —Jean Felber: Event is set for Sunday, Nov. 10th in the newly remodeled hall in Stanley. Diane Weggen brought tickets for Christmas Cash Raffle (to be drawn at 1pm, Nov. 10th) 10 to 1 odds and \$5050 in prizes. Volunteers to record the ticket numbers for each church location are as follows: St. Rose (Lorrie Sonnentag), Julie Lingen (Holy Family, and Pam Dorn (St. Joseph). Volunteers for the organization committee are: Ann Wagner, Char Zenner, Diane Weggen, and Carol Meyer *Julie Lingen mentioned to look closely at the new rules for the use of the hall when decorating to stay in compliance with the rental contract. Ideas of “booths” and “activities” for the event were offered and it was suggested to reach out to the youth of the parish for help in working the event.
3. Cash Raffle (see above)
4. Possible Funding for Hall projects:
 - a. Racks for Pantry--\$399.96
 - b. Vacuum cleaner=estimated price \$150-200
 - c. Shop vac-- \$50-100
 - d. Freezer for bar
 - e. Floor scrubber
 - f. Round tables and rack for storage
 - g. Shelf unit for cooler
 - h. Bulletin Board (to post necessary papers in the kitchen)
 - i. Spray paint for railing \$20

Diane Weggen made a motion to have the PCCW give \$1500 for items a-d, h, & i The motion was seconded by Pam Dorn. The discussion was to clarify if the items cost more than \$1500, it would be brought back to the PCCW for further consideration, or the executive committee would decide on the expense. The motion passed unanimously.
