Holy Family Brunch Report: The brunch held December 8th was very successful. The council served 200 people a delicious breakfast brunch. Comments made by customers were the excellent taste, reasonable price, and amount of food was too much. Total income was \$2460.00, and expenses were \$784.01 which resulted in a profit of \$1675.99. Five of the twelve family of the month joined us as guests of the council and received a certificate and a picture taken of them for the council history book. The brunch was held to fulfill the RSVP (Refund Support Vocations Program) program one of the Faith in Action Programs. At the Nov-Dec meeting it was voted on to give Seminarian Joseph Glatczak \$500 from the proceeds and an additional \$500 from the Charity Fund.

Dues: The 2024 year is over and of the eighty -eight members that need to pay dues only fourteen did not pay. Total membership at the end of the year was 120 members. Thirty-two of them are Life members which do not have to pay dues. To be a Life member you need to be 70 years old and have been a member for 25 years. The 2025 dues billing will be sent out in mid-April. The dues will remain the same at \$23.00 and a voluntary contribution of \$3.65 or more for Penny a Knight a Day (PKD) for Catholic education.
