

## **All Saints PCCW Agenda**

### **All Saints Parish Hall and Family Center**

**Opening Prayer:** Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel--Jean

#### **Old Business:**

1. Treasure Report: Ann: Starting balance as of July 1<sup>st</sup> =\$4344.60  
Income of \$150 (from a funeral) minus expenses leaves a balance of \$1888.31. Future expenses include \$24.14 for coffee, cups, and napkins, \$118.80 for baptismal gifts, and \$612.70 for items for the hall.
2. Circle Reports:
  - St Joseph: Pam Dorn reported on the rosary rally with 9 in attendance. The Boyd ladies served Jessica Ryba funeral service.
  - Holy Family: Ann
  - St. Rose of Lima: Lorrie Sonnentag said the rosary rally had 8 in attendance.
3. Funeral Restructure update Jenn: There was a committee meeting over a month ago. It was decided to structure them with Jenn Rogalski as the contact person (Jean Felber is the alternate) for the funeral homes. She would then call the group leaders to reach out to their respective groups. Groups will rotate through as funerals occur. Jenn will call the leader when they are up for the next funeral (on call). The groups will be a mixed group from all the parishes. There will be a supply cabinet for all the items needed for funerals. Concern was risen about contacting someone for praying a rosary for the deceased. Jenn said she would make it clear to the funeral directors that this is separate from the funeral dinner. A meal plan will be offered for the families to choose from or options for caterers. The hall cost is \$1000 for a non-parishioner but not for a parishioner. Training will be given on hygiene practices even though there would be no inspections during funeral dinners.  
The committee is asking for group leaders (training will be given). There could possibly a "Saturday Only" group for those that can only offer help on Saturdays.
4. Christmas Bazaar/ Cash Raffle –Jenn: Sign-up sheets were passed around to sign up to help in various parts of the Christmas Bazaar. We were asked to reach out to businesses for donations for the silent auction. Father Felix has decided that the "Open House" for the hall will be in conjunction with the bazaar (same day). Advertising and invitations

are pertinent to increasing attendance. Update on ticket sales, tickets are selling very well.

5. Update on funding for Hall project –Julie: Inspection of the kitchen is Thursday, Oct 24<sup>th</sup>. Asked for prayers to pass the inspection. There is approximately \$300 remaining of the allotted funds for various items for the hall. There is a little more to purchase so we should be able to stay in the allotted funds.
6. Follow up on sportsman dinner: 4 people helped with cleanup which earned the PCCW \$300. There are details being worked out with the hall rental before the payment can be made to the PCCW.
7. Date for Pork Dinner—To be held in Cadott in the Spring with the possibility of having another pork dinner in the fall. We are looking at holding the dinner on Palm Sunday (April 13<sup>th</sup>). Recommended to Barb Peterson and Laurie Sonnentag (co-chairs) to put the pork dinner on the Nov. meeting agenda and to call a separate meeting in Cadott to organize the event. The co-chairs were asked to compile an approximate budget to present at the Dec. meeting.

#### **New Business:**

8. PCCW was asked to help for Knights of Columbus 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary dinner Nov. 2  
The discussion was tabled to talk with the Knights to make sure the help is needed.
9. Christmas Party -December 12—All Saints Parish Hall and Family Center. 6pm, potluck, invitations will be given to Falther Felix, and Deacon Willkom. Laurie Setzer and Julie Lingen will decorate and set up bingo. Jenn motioned to allow up to \$125 for prizes, Barb Peterson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
10. Julie Lingen brought up a request from the diocese to fill out a form to “Thank a pastor” which the diocese will compile and give to each pastor that gets responses.
