**Pastor's Message:** Fr. Felix:

1. Health is improving and feeling better.
2. Having some issues with the hall (door, electricity, lights).
3. Hall project took all of the "Inspired by The Spirit" campaign monies.
4. Going forward- "Inspired by The Spirit" campaign funds should go to St. Joseph capital improvements.
5. Meeting with Knights and others to develop policies (hall committee) so that everyone is on the same page.
6. Tuesday Game Night: Knights in Chippewa have bingo weekly and have made approx. \$150,000/year. If we make money, then we don't need to take out of the capital improvement fund. Father will talk to the Knights and we can all work together (ladies, men, and children). A bingo board was purchased for \$1000 from Plover. Father promised to call bingo at times. Jerry Dirkes is applying for the bingo license. The Knights are taking charge of bingo and the PCCW is taking charge of the concessions (start simple; hotdogs, chips, etc.) Dec. 6<sup>th</sup>-want a group to go to KC in Chippewa to see how they do it (doors open at 5, bingo 7-9:15). Anyone can attend. Once set up, 50% of proceeds go to capital improvements, 25% to Knights and PCCW each. Groups can be contacted to help in a weekly rotation. School, Knights, and PCCW can sell raffles, and some money can go to charity. Goal to start in January.
