Opening Prayer: Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel—Jean

Meeting called to order at 7:04

Pastor's Message: Fr. Felix-Not able to attend but mentioned that there will be a meeting in June for those involved with the parish hall to look at how the management and rental is going and evaluate any changes. There will also be a meeting discussing bingo and evaluating any changes along with distribution of profits.

Old Business:

1. Treasure Report: Ann Wagner
Balance=\$14,851.39
From this amount, expected expenses of approx. \$8000 for the floor scrubber, approximately \$1300 to Diocese for Mercy Sunday collection, \$500 for shelving, and prizes from Mother's Day Raffle.
2. Circle Reports:
Pam Dorn: Will be out of reach until June 2nd. Nothing new.
Ann Wagner: Julie Lingen is getting bids for marble counter tops for statue bases
Lorrie Sonnentag: Mercy Sunday collection was over \$660 & thank you to those who helped at bingo and making it such a success.
3. Funeral/Events/Bingo update: Jenn Rogalski- Lindsey Nolechek is assisting with organizing help with an upcoming funeral. There's a wedding this summer where help will be needed.
4. Mother's Day Raffle—Diane Weggen (not in attendance) Approx. \$4000 in profit
5. Mercy Sunday (April 27) collection—Jean Felber- (see above) Funds will be sent to the diocesan level of PCCW
6. Birdhouse Fundraiser—Lorrie Sonnentag- Dan Schmidt made 40 birdhouses. Lorrie made a marketing plan to offer a free birdhouse for anyone who bought 5 Mother's Day raffle tickets. 5 people took her up on the offer so she covered the cost of 5 birdhouses.

New Business:

1. Financial assistance for "the Answer" in August-Melissa Cochran: In the 3rd year of the Eucharistic revival and Melissa is offering to order tickets for people who might not be tech savvy and has a sign up in the back of the churches to commit to tickets and to see who might need a ride to coordinate ride-shares. Melissa asked the PCCW for possible

scholarship funds to sponsor tickets to anyone who wants to go but might not be able to afford tickets. A motion was made by Pam Dorn to allow up to \$400 to offer scholarships toward tickets to the Eucharistic Rally in Eau Claire to fill the needs as expressed. Melissa Cochran seconded the motion. Melissa Cochran said she'd put anyone in need in contact with Jean Felber (council president). Motion carried unanimously.

2. Cadott improvement--Jenn: Tabled until fall
 - Sink and faucet area along the back wall
 - Pantry improvements
 - Roaster Refresh/sharing between churches
3. Shirt Conversation: Jean Arneson is developing a logo and the conversation for PCCW shirts will continue at a later date. Need to consider national logo and copyright issues.
4. Nomination Committee: Jean Felber- VP, treasurer, and secretary positions are coming to term and the nomination committee would develop a method of gathering nominations from all 3 churches. The new president would appoint representatives from each church to sit on the executive board. Nominations are due by the March meeting, Elections in April, Installation in May.
5. Other: An update was given on the project in development of the church directory. Jean Felber, Jenn Rogalski, and Char Zenner are organizing this project for the end of July-beginning of August. It was noted that while collecting contact information for the directory, this information will also be added to "flock note" (a church directory app) for a complete parish directory. The photo sessions are planned for 2 days in Cadott, 2 days in Boyd, and 4-6 days at the parish hall in Stanley.
6. Lorrie Sonnentag brought attention to "Rosary in a Year" with Father Mark Mary, a podcast from Ascension. She encourages all members to join the app with the podcast or look it up on YouTube. She suggested reading "When the White Smoke Clears," a new book about Pope Leo XIV from Ascension Press.
