Opening Prayer: Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel—Jean

Called to order at 6:30pm

Pastor's Message: Fr. Felix will address the capital campaign at the weekend Masses and asks us to regularly pray a prayer to St. Joseph

Old Business:

1. Treasure Report: Ann Wagner (unable to attend): Balance \$15,935.79 with an upcoming expense of \$210 for Fr. Joseph Glatczyk's reception.
2. Circle Reports:
Pam Dorn: (Boyd) hosted Fr. Joseph's reception held in Boyd and decorated beautifully by Nancy Kowalczyk. There is a large funeral being held in Boyd Sept. 20 (Bourget) and looking for servers. Pam would like to retire as Boyd representative.
Ann Wagner (absent): Nothing to report for Stanley
Lorrie Sonnentag: For those that weren't able to attend "Still The Answer" in Eau Claire, there was rain and were unable to have the processional. Asked about the Rosary Rally for Oct. 11th and will check with the social concerns committee. Reminder: the fall "Care-a-thon" for the radio station starts on Monday, Sept. 22nd.
3. Funeral/Events/Bingo update: Jenn Rogalski: Sept. 27th is the Sportsman's Club banquet at the hall so we have areas where help is needed. No other events for the hall. Bingo started Sept. 2nd with a winner of the progressive and a steady attendance of about 60 people since.
4. Flowers- Jenn Rogalski: Father has expressed an interest in artificial flowers to mingle in with real flowers for the holidays throughout the year. Diane Weggen made a motion to budget \$1000 to purchase artificial flowers for all three churches, primarily for Christmas. Motion seconded by Tina Williams. Motion carried. Plans will be made to organize a day to create the flower arrangements after they are purchased.
5. "Still the Answer" scholarships—Jean Felber: 4 scholarships for tickets were given, and about 25 parishioners attended.
6. Update Parish Directory: In the process of putting the directory together for a committee to approve prior to printing. Approximately 1/3 of the parish members had photos taken.
7. "Corn Fest" in Boyd: PCCW had a booth to sell popcorn. Lois Esslinger popped all the popcorn and Jean picked it up from the theater. It was sold for \$1 per bag. We made

about \$45 at the event. The event was cut short due to thunderstorms. It was suggested to attend again next year to let people know who we are and support the community.

New Business:

1. Christmas/Fall Bazaar: We are holding off on doing a raffle this fall but would like to have a bazaar. After much discussion, it was decided to hold a Christmas Bazaar on Nov. 9th. Lorrie Sonnentag offered to organize the dinner and will contact some ladies for help. Julie Lingen will organize the bake sale, Jenn Rogalski will organize the silent auction, Kim Gundlach will get teenagers for serving, Diane Weggen offered assistance and will reach out to a few ladies to ask for their help with the meal.
2. Where to spend/donate money: We held a discussion on costs and where money will be spent but final decisions were not made at this time. More information will be gathered and presented at the next meeting so a vote can be held.
 - Donation to Hall Loan:
 - Donation to St Joseph's Centennial Campaign: Diane Weggen moved that the profits from the 2025 Christmas Bazaar go to the Centennial Campaign. Seconded by Pam Dorn. Motion passed. Jenn Rogalski offered to do the advertising for the Christmas Bazaar to highlight that the proceeds will go to the Centennial Campaign.
 - Garbage cans for Boyd and Cadott, Stainless rack for pantry, roasters for parish use, chair wraps and table clothes/napkins.
 - Merchandizing cooler for drinks at Bingo—Jenn Rogalski: A new one is about \$4000 or a "scratch & dent" cooler is about \$3000. Inserts to hold up drinks could be an extra cost.
3. Cadott improvement--Jenn: Tabled for next meeting
 - Sink and faucet area along the back wall
 - Pantry improvements
 - Roaster Refresh/sharing between churches
4. Shirt Conversation: Tabled for later
5. Nomination Committee—Can NOT be from the executive board.
