Old Business:

1. Treasure Report: Ann Wagner; Balance after the Sportsman's banquet=\$16,072.73
2. Christmas Bazaar (signup sheets for working in the various areas of the bazaar were at the entrance to look over before the meeting)
 - Kitchen/Dinner: Ann Wagner and Lorrie Sonnentag (unable to attend); food is ordered, and a crew is needed to work the dinner and there's a list of items that can be donated.
 - Bake Sale: Julie Lingen Would like to use a rolling rack or extra table to hold baked goods. She will use red table covers for the bake sale tables. Label the items but there is no need to price them.
 - Kids Bucket Raffle: Carol Meyer and Marilyn Bowe; would like a couple of teenagers to help. We hope to block off the room prior to announcing winners to avoid heavy traffic in the "bar room". As prizes/donations come in, it will be decided if there will be a game to win that item or if there will be 2 tiers of tickets (25 cents/\$1) depending on the value of the prizes.
 - This and That Table: Denise Thornton; taking donations for books
 - Bingo: Char Zenner; We have the bingo board this year and will have prizes. We will limit to 1 hour of play.
 - Silent Auction: Jenn Rogalski; Items can be dropped off at the parish office and empty baskets, that can be filled, can also be dropped off. Jenn will be at the hall starting on Thursday prior to the bazaar.
 - Advertising: Jenn; put an ad in the shopper once, the week of the event. Jenn will give images to Lori Setzer and Kim Gundlach for Facebook and the parish website.
 - Other: Kim Gundlach has a list of 13 names she will contact to confirm help from teenagers, and she will ask Shannon Hoel or another adult to assist with keeping the teens on task.
3. Potential Expenditures:
 - Hall Loan: proceeds from Bingo (\$5000)
 - Steubenville Scholarships—multiple, appox. \$600 per attendee==a lot \$3000

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- We were given a “wish list” of items to purchase and a motion was made by Marilyn Bowe to purchase a custom-made shelf for the pantry in the hall, 2-6qt roasters, and 2 anti-fatigue mats for the kitchen in the hall. The motion was seconded by Anita Boos and passed unanimously.

Until a logo is ready, it was suggested to use an image of Our Lady of Good Counsel or a flower on the header of the newsletter which would be inserted in the bulletin as soon as possible following the monthly meetings.
