Opening Prayer: Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel—meeting called to order at 6:35pm

Pastor's Message: Fr. Felix-update on the capital campaign for the St. Joseph Church repairs & construction. So far, \$440,165.00 cash has been donated and \$263,711.00 is pledged for the next 5 years. There will be another meeting on Nov. 25th to talk more about the bidding on contractors and future plans for the project and the development of a contract for the contractors to hopefully begin in the spring. Father gave a breakdown of the possibly of donations to make the project affordable and after going through some math and donation options, "it isn't out of the realm of possibility".

Old Business:

1. Treasure Report: Ann Wagner- We currently have a balance of \$21,751.80. We still need to collect from 2 funerals so that will add to our balance. Expenses coming up are \$2336.11 for multiple items approved at previous meetings.
2. Christmas Bazaar wrap up and donation to St. Joseph Centennial Campaign: Jenn Rogalski- Total expenses of \$2006.29 with an income of \$8581.45 for a profit of \$6575.16 (which was approved to donate to the St. Joseph Church Centennial campaign). There was a motion made by Linda Gindt seconded by Denise Thornton to incur expenses and increase the total donation to \$10,000. The motion passed unanimously. The volunteer help was incredible and included 60 adult volunteers and 14 teens. 289 meals were served and many compliments were received by our PCCW members.
3. Potential Expenditures:
 - Hall Loan: proceeds from Bingo was \$5000 from the winter of 2025. Denise Thornton made a motion to donate \$5000 to the All Saints Parish Hall loan, seconded by Diane Weggen, passed unanimously.
 - Steubenville Scholarships—cost is approx \$600 per attendee. Melissa Cochran presented the request for scholarship funds for our parish youth to attend. Diane Weggen made a motion to allocate up to \$3000 for scholarships to Steubenville conference, seconded by Donna Keck, passed unanimously. It will be determined at a later date of how much will be used from this allocation determined by the attendance and how much is raised through fundraisers by the youth attendees themselves.

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New Business:

1. Christmas Gifts: There was a motion to give \$500 each to Deacon Willkom and Fr. Felix, \$100 each to Julie Lingen and Lori Setzer, \$330 to the religious education volunteers (\$1530 total), seconded by Denise Thornton, passed unanimously.
2. Cheer basket- assembly is set for Dec 13th at St. Joseph Church starting at 9am and delivered the same day. There are approximately 100 baskets made up and given. Donations of candy, fruit, and cookies are welcome. Our youth created ornaments and Christmas cards to put in the cheer baskets.
3. PCCW Christmas party is Dec 11th at All Saints Parish Hall starting at 6:00. Bring a dish to pass. Ann Wagner offered to make punch. We will play some bingo or a dice game and bring a wrapped gift for prizes.
4. Prayer Chain: It is being considered to use "Flock notes" (contact information gathered for the parish during the directory photography sessions) to send mass emails to all those willing to pray for the requests that come in. Jean Felber is willing to head this project. As more information becomes available, we will be updated.
