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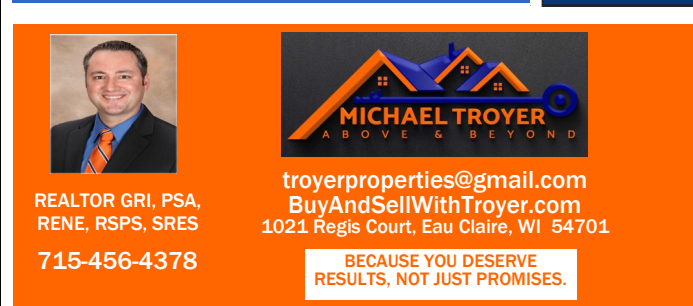

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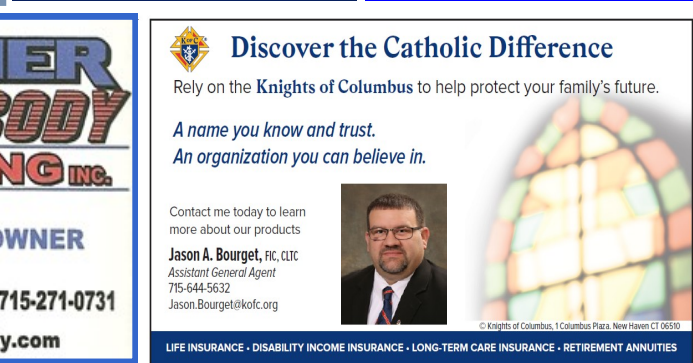
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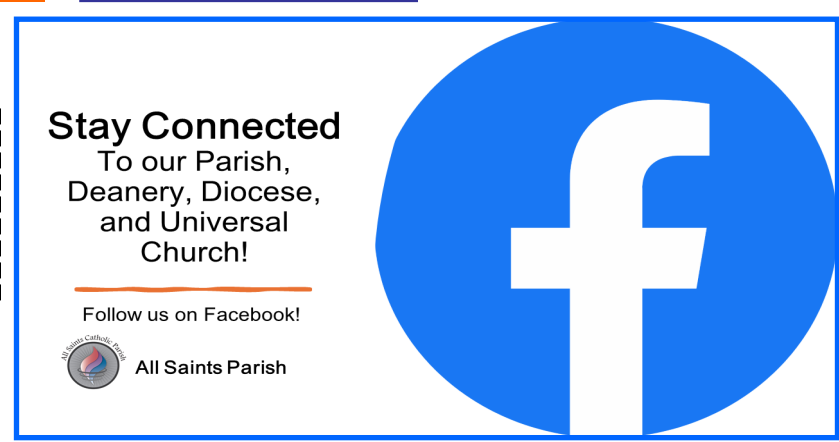

+ Fifth Sunday of Easter

With the celebration of Confirmation at St. Charles Borromeo Church in Chippewa Falls this Sunday afternoon, and the celebration of First Holy Communion last Sunday, brings to the conclusion of this year's sacramental preparation for our youth. I want to extend my deepest gratitude to our school and religious education teachers and formators for their time and dedication. I truly hope that all of the parents of our young people show your appreciation towards them as well.

Given the age we live in; we often find the need to play "catch up" in our formation programs. Young families do not always come to us by the front door, so to speak, meaning that Catholic faith and practice may not have been front and center for a time in life. Marriages may have taken place in a civil, non-sacramental setting. Children approaching the age of First Holy Communion, may not have been previously baptized. On some occasions, we find some children and young people desiring the sacraments but may have parents who are not Catholic. The order of things is not as it was.

While all of this is a bit challenging, Deacon Willkom and I approach sacramental preparation as a household or family ministry. In a given situation, parents may need to have their marriages sacramentally blessed. This might involve parents needing preparation for Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation themselves. The reason for all of this is really not our concern. We simply want to help and serve individuals and whole families to fully enter into the sacramental life of Christ and his Church.

The life of faith, and life in general, is quite confusing and chaotic these days. It is our hope that adults and families will simply come forward to ask what they need to do to put things in order and live a full sacramental life. I always look at Easter as a reminder of the saving grace that comes from the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord and poured forth in the sacraments he gave us. He came and gave himself for us so that we may have life, and have it to the fullest!
