### The Pastor's Journal...

+ Sixth Sunday of Easter

Here's to all of our mothers, grandmothers, and spiritual mothers as our nation celebrates Mother's Day. Back in 1995 (ancient history now) Pope Saint John Paul II wrote a most beautiful letter to women. In it, he said this: "Thank you, women who are mothers! You have sheltered human beings within yourselves in a unique experience of joy and travail. This experience makes you become God's own smile upon the newborn child, the one who guides your child's first steps, who helps it to grow, and who is the anchor as the child makes its way along the journey of life." All of us should be aware of the important role our own mother played in who we are and what we become. Honor them with great love, even those who have passed. Say a little prayer of thanks for giving us our mothers.

Each year the Bishop of our diocese sets aside one week for his priests to make their annual canonical retreat. The code of canon law, the guiding law of the Church, says: "Clerics (priests and deacons) have a special obligation to seek holiness in their lives, because they are consecrated to God by a new title through the reception of orders, and are stewards of the mysteries of God in the service of his people. In order that they can pursue this perfection they are in the first place faithfully and untiringly to fulfill their obligations of pastoral ministry.... They are also obliged to make spiritual retreats. (CC 276)."

Most of the priests, including me, will be on retreat this coming week. I ask that you keep, not only me, but all of the priests who will be engaged in a spiritual retreat in your daily prayers. I have, on occasion, had parishioners ask why a priest needs to go on retreat since he spends most of his time preparing for or celebrating the sacraments, prayers, and devotions of the Church, in addition to all of his pastoral ministry? It all goes back to Jesus and his apostles as recorded in the gospels. After an extensive period of preaching, teaching, and pastoral care of those who sought out Jesus and his apostles, Jesus would say to them, "Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while (Mark 6:31)." They were so busy sometimes they didn't even have time to eat. Jesus' invitation represents a compassionate, and wise call to withdraw from overwhelming ministry demands to find rest, renewal, and quiet intimacy with him.

The time after Easter often brings to a close, a very intense and hectic pastoral work in a parish and diocese. Priests have relatively little time to spend in the company of each other apart from ministerial duties. I often say that when Jesus ordained his men they became a "band of brothers" to carry out his work generation after generation. The "band of brothers" need time to reconnect, not only with each other, but with the Lord himself. Know that you are never far from the prayers and Masses of priests on their retreat.
