

All Saints PCCW Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:34pm

Opening Prayer: Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel--Jean

Old Business:

1. Treasure Report: report provided by Ann Wagner; as of April 14th, the balance = \$9313.76 includes Mercy Sunday collection was \$1321.32 which will go to the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women.
2. Steubenville youth conference: Kim Gundlach asked for volunteers willing to sell tickets for the "Made from the Heart" raffle coordinated for our youth attending the conference. We are sending 4 youth and 1 chaperone from our parish so help with fundraising is appreciated.
3. Nominations for board members: Julie is putting slips in the churches to collect nominees. The nominees will be contacted to determine those that will be on the ballot. We hope to have a vote prior to May meeting, so the new team can be announced.
4. Beautification committee: All areas of concern regarding flower beds and grounds issues, at all churches and the hall, were discussed for upcoming maintenance.

New Business:

1. Decorations for grave sites for deceased priests in our cemeteries: We have 13 priest buried in out commentaries. The purchase of crosses has been decided and volunteers for the distribution was determined.
2. Merchandizing Fridge: Jenn Rogalski asked for funding for a Coca-Cola cooler available locally for \$550. Marilyn Bowe made a motion to purchase it. The motion was seconded by Theresa Forman. This cooler is for All Saints Hall which would be most convenient for use during bingo nights. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Meal Prep Party - Stephanie Schuebel brought an idea to the PCCW which Jenn Rogalski explained to the group. The idea is a meal prep day making bags of pre-made crockpot meals. After some discussion, questions were listed to ask Stephanie for more information.

4. Puzzle Tournament: Jenn Rogalski explained the possibility of making a puzzle tournament into a fundraiser. She has 20 of the same Christmas themed puzzles. It was suggested to make it a “Christmas in July puzzle tournament”. The cost would be \$40 per team. Typically, there would be teams of 4 so it would be \$10 each. It is a timed event with small breaks. There is a possibility of having a meal or some snacks after or during breaks. A motion was made by Ann Wagner to have a budget of \$200 for advertising and other expenses to put this event together to be held July 19th 1-5pm. Lou Ann Wilkom seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
5. Jenn Rogalski made a motion to budget \$250 for the purchase of at least 15 acrylic brochure holders for organizing pamphlets in the back of the churches. Mary Cole seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
