Well, it is official. The last weekend Mass for St. Joseph Church in Boyd will be the 10:30am Mass on Sunday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. As I mentioned last weekend, we will continue to have the Tuesday and Friday weekday Masses. Those coming to Mass should park in the parking lot of the church/school and enter through the west door. No large capacity Masses are allowed because of building and safety codes. The plan is to complete the project in time for Christmas.

I mentioned to the building and grounds committee that having the first Mass on Christmas Day is somewhat providential. When the church was first built nearly 100 years ago, the very first Mass celebrated in it was the Christmas Mass. It wasn't until the summer that the bishop came for the Mass of dedication and consecration. Once the project is complete and we return to our regular schedule, we can begin planning for the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St. Joseph Church 2028-2029. Bishop Battersby already said he is looking forward to coming and celebrating with us.

Deacon Willkom and I were in La Crosse on Saturday for the ordination of six new permanent deacons for our diocese. Among the six very fine men, one is our neighbor, Deacon Patrick Conley from St. Bernard - St. Hedwig in Thorp. It has been a joy to work with these men throughout the five years of their formation. They will be a true blessing for their respective parish, deanery, and the whole Diocese of La Crosse.

This Thursday, June 11, the bishops of the United States will make a special act of consecration of our nation to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, as part of their annual Plenary Assembly meeting in Orlando, Florida, coinciding with the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our nation. 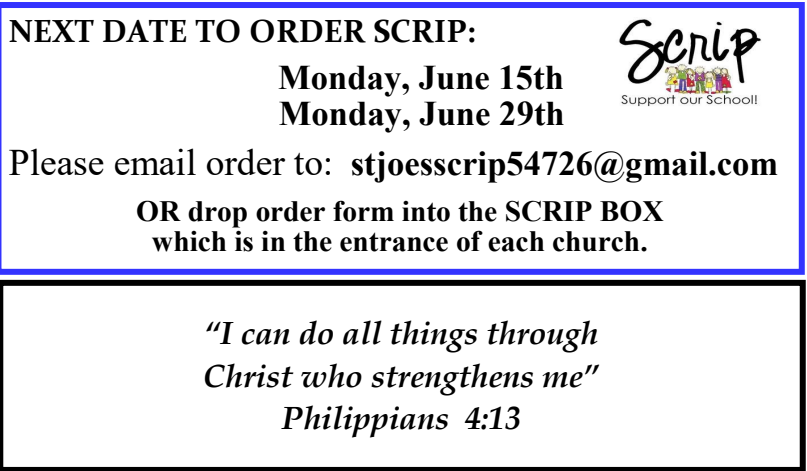

Read slowly from one of the Gospels, meditating on the words and deeds of Jesus, asking Him to help you to see how they apply to you. Then rest in silence and listen. Do this for a few minutes each day.
